## From the Finance Team

We want to celebrate the generosity shown to make the emergency roof replacement last fall. Glory to God! A total of **\$187,000** has been raised! **\$27,000** is still needed as families complete their commitments. We had an additional cost of **\$20,000** in the same season to replace air handling units over the sanctuary.

As we look to the coming year our invitation is that faithful folks continue pray about how they might give sacrificially to support the mission of St Joseph UMC. Last fall we cut more than \$70,000 from our budgets for staffing to reduce more than half of our significant budget shortfall (a need for a 10% increase in overall giving remains projected). We believe, however, that the time for cuts has come to a close and the time to do ministry has begun. Please pray about how God might use your financial gifts and talents as we step into the hopeful future before us!
